Preparation:

- Print and laminate the pages. Cut out the cards along the dotted lines.

Directions:

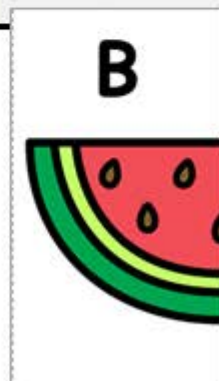
- Lay out all the cards or chose 4-5 sets

- Continue until all the letters are matched.



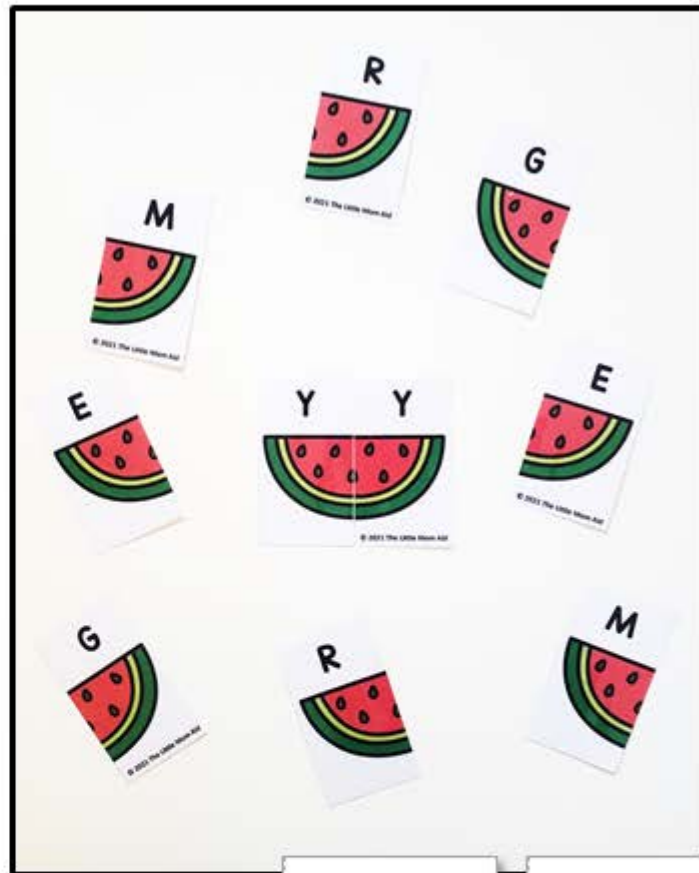
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Letter Ww Mat

Preparation:

- Print the Ww mat.
- Laminate the mat if you wish to reuse it.

Materials:

- Small manipulatives to fill the letters such as black beans, glass beads, buttons or mini erasers.
- If you do not laminate it your learner can fill in the letters with paint, crayons, markers, bingo markers or even stickers.

Directions:

- Review the letter name and the letter sound.
- Trace the letters with fingers.
- Decorate the letter.

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Watermelon Beginning Sounds

Preparation:

- Print and laminate the pages. Cut out the task cards along the dotted lines.

Materials:

- Black beans, play dough, mini erasers, beads, pompoms, buttons, etc.

Directions:

- You can use all the cards or chose 4-5.
- Pick a card, name the picture and identify the beginning sound.
- Cover the letters that correspond with beginning sound.



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Watermelon Prewriting Strips

Preparation:

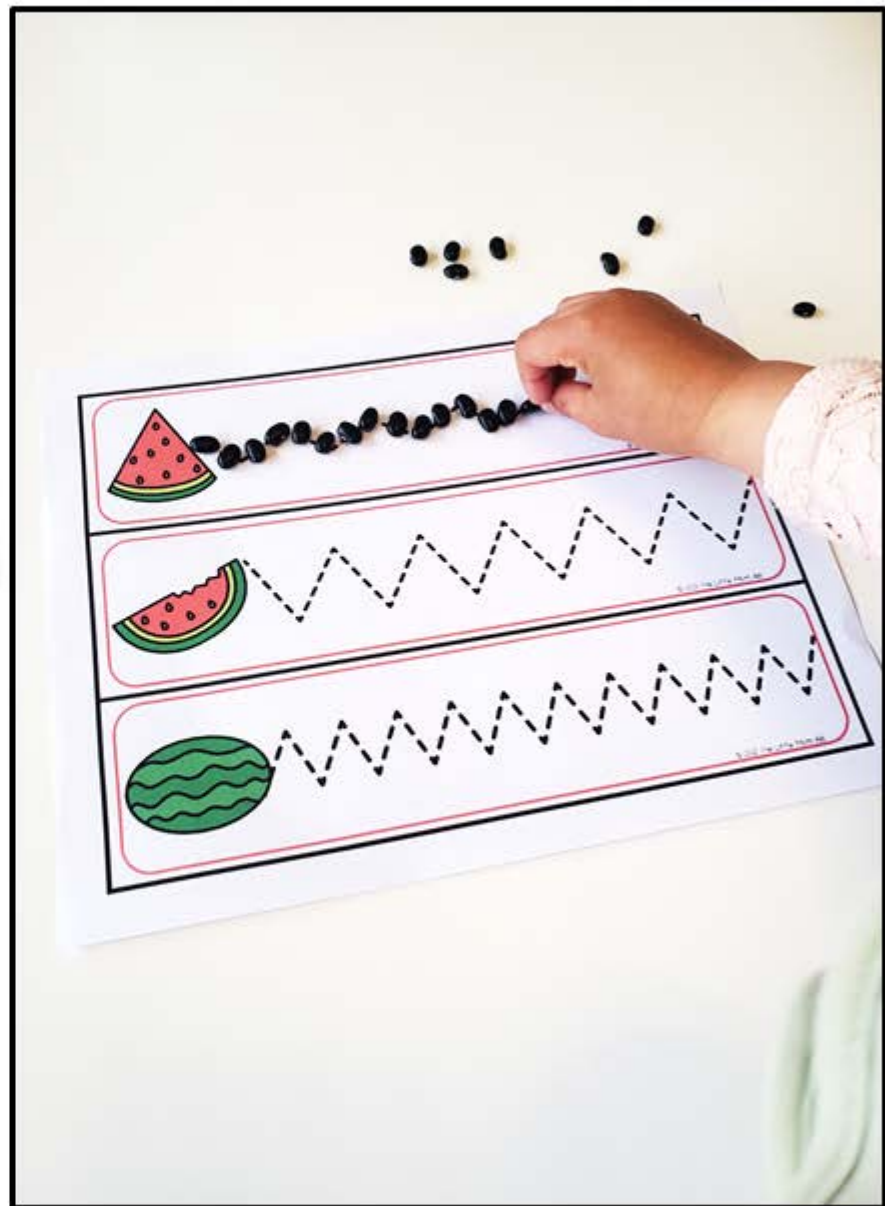
- Print and laminate the pages. Cut out the strips.
- You may also print the pages and place in sheet protectors.

Materials:

- Dry erase markers or small manipulatives like black beans, buttons, pompoms, mini erasers, etc.

Directions:

- Use a dry erase marker or small manipulatives to trace the lines on the prewriting strip.



Watermelon Count and Stack Mats

Preparation:

- Print the Watermelon Count and Stack Mats and the recording sheets.
- Laminate the mats if you wish to reuse them.

Materials:

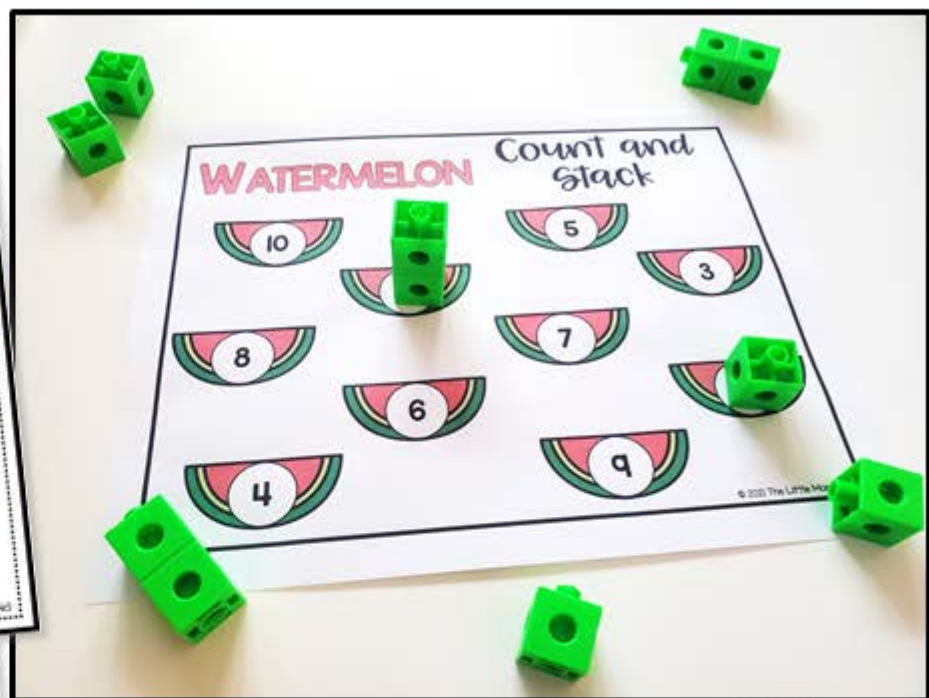
- Unifix cubes / snap cubes

Directions:

- Use the recording sheet to practice writing numbers.

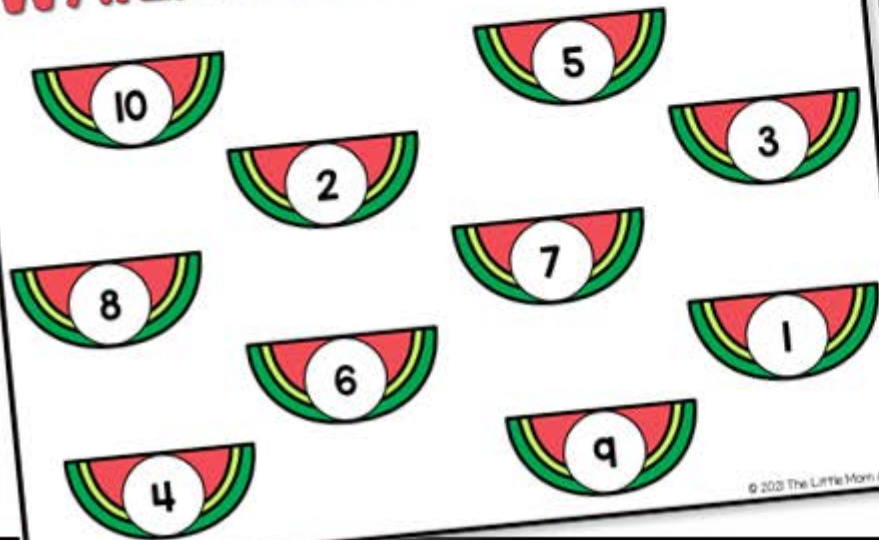

Materials:

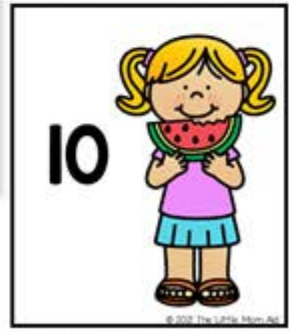
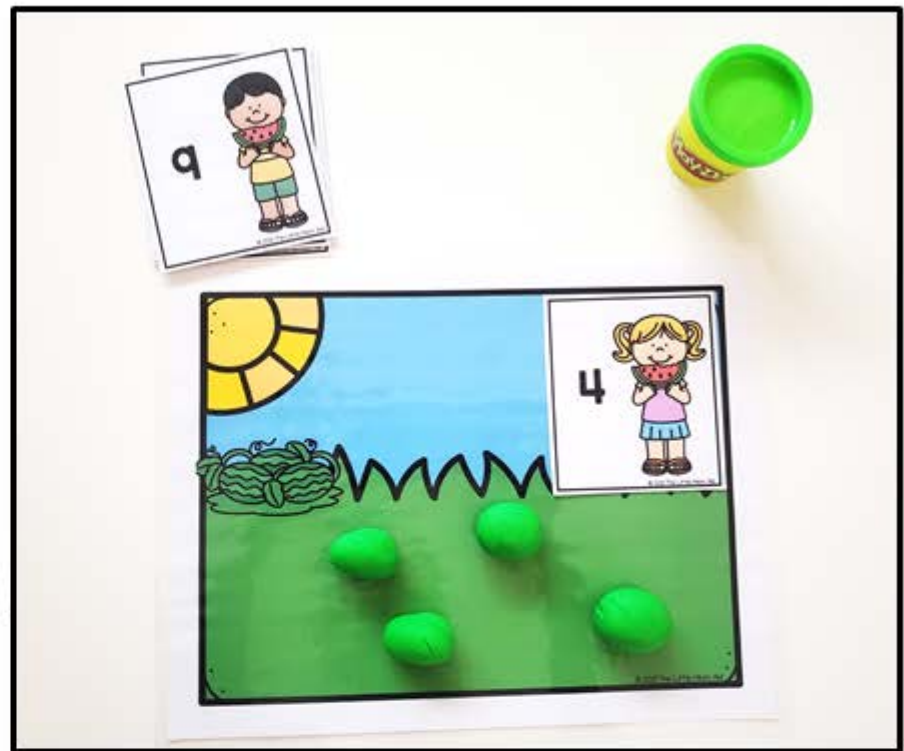
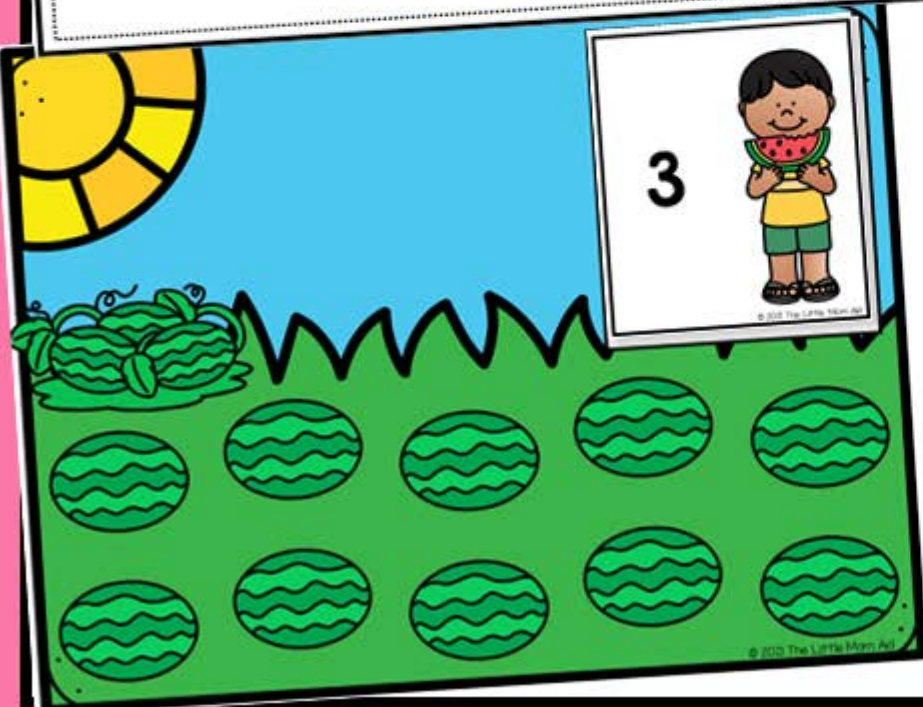
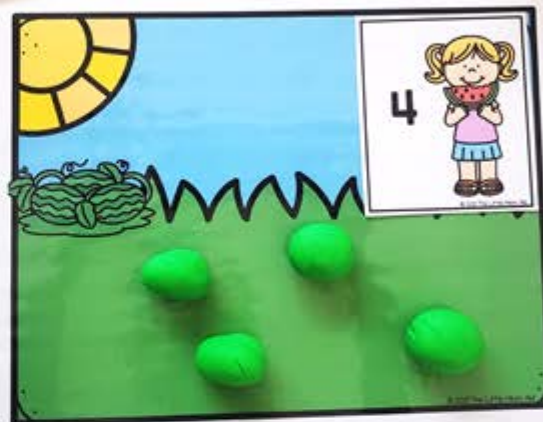
- Green play dough

- Count the corresponding number of seeds and place them on the watermelon.



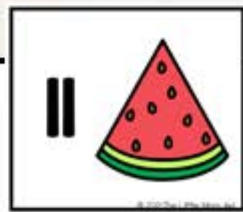
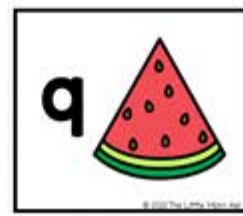
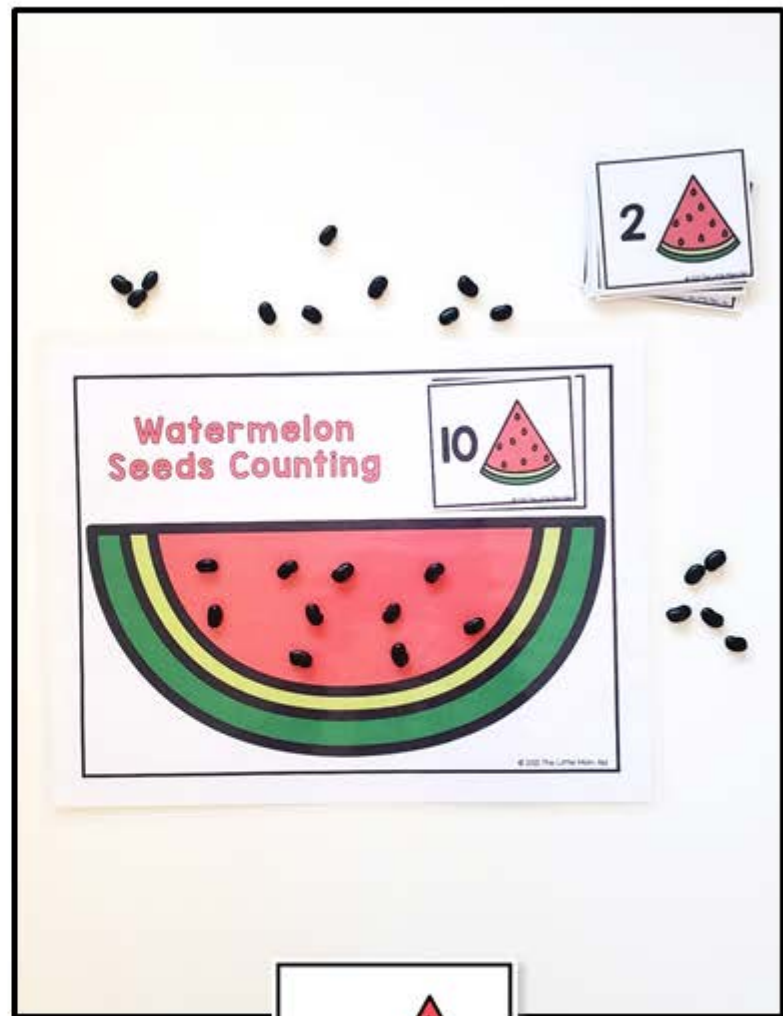

- Red, green and black play dough.

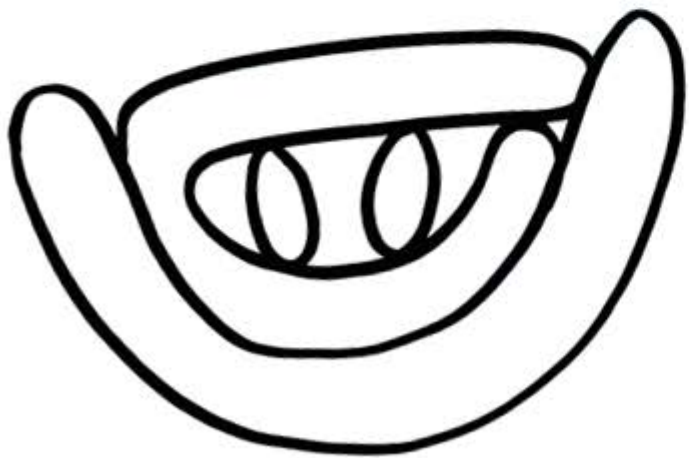
Directions:
